#### FORMAT (15 minutes + 2 second increment)

7 round separate Swiss tournaments for the Primary and Secondary schools. This is an ACF Rated Tournament.

\*\* In the event of insufficient number of players for either the Primary or Secondary Category, the 2 categories will be combined as one. Trophies will still be awarded according to the Primary and Secondary School Categories.

## Eligibility:

Any individual girl who is in the primary or secondary division. There is no minimum number required to form a school team. This means a player can come on her own to represent a school if there are no other players from that school. Individual trophies will still be awarded in such scenarios.

## \*PRIZES

Primary and Secondary School Category

- 1st, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> School Trophies (Please take note that to be awarded a school trophy, the school team MUST consist of at least 4 players)
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> team player trophy. The top 4 players of the top 3 winning school team will be awarded a Trophy
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Individual Trophies for best individual performance overall
- 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Individual Trophies for player with a rating of 500 and below. This prize is awarded to any player who has an ACF quick rating of 500 and below or unrated.
- Merit trophies may be awarded to any player who had performed exceptionally well but not make it to top 3. This will be at the discretion of the organizers.

\*Kindly take note that to be eligible for any individual prize, a player must achieve a score of 50% or greater (i.e., 3.5/7). If two or more players or teams end up with the same score, tiebreak rules will be utilized to determine the winner. Tie Break Format will be decided by the Chief Arbiter on the day.
